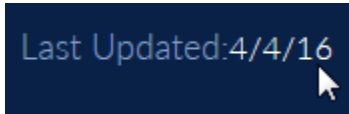


Embed Video from YouTube

These instructions describe how to embed video from YouTube onto an mccd.edu webpage edited with OmniUpdate OU Campus. Though the instructions specify YouTube, you can use the embed code from other video sharing services.

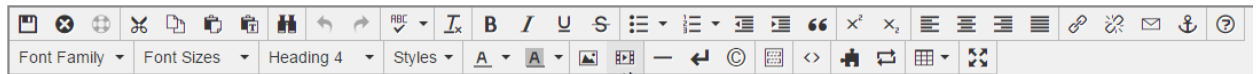
1. From a webpage to which you have editing access, log into OU Campus.



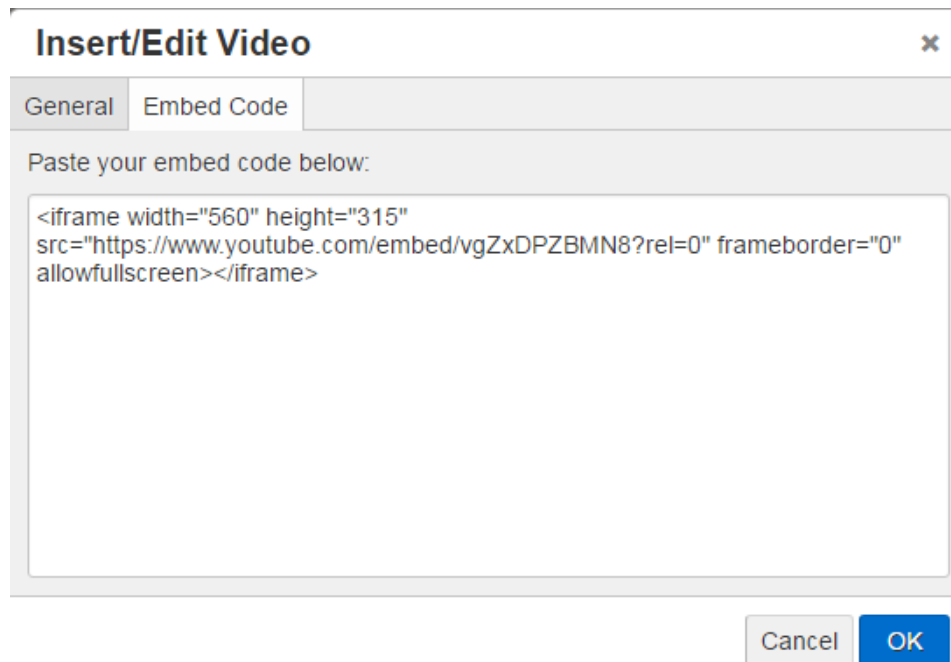
2. Click the Main Content button to toggle into editing mode:



3. From the editing tool bar, select the Insert/Edit Video icon  :



4. In the Insert/Edit Video dialog box, click the Embed Code tab and paste embed code from YouTube. Click OK:

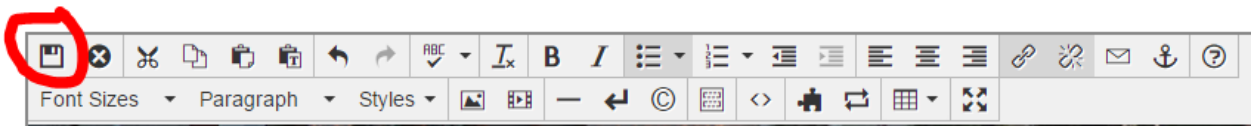




TIP: You can modify the embed code from **YouTube** to turn off suggested videos which appear once your video has ended. Simply add **?rel=0** to the end of the URL string as so:

```

```

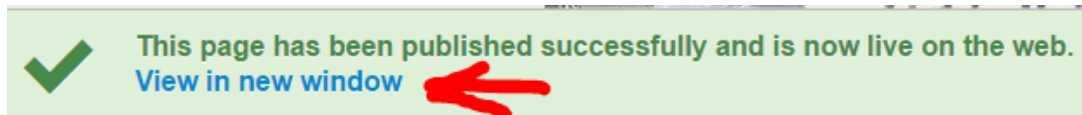
- Once you are done with your edits, click the Save icon to exit and save your file.



- Click Publish, then Publish again in the Final Check dialog box.





- After a successful publish, a message will be displayed at the bottom of the page you just edited. Click on the link to view in a new window.
