Reporting to Legal Authorities

Survivors have the right to have an advocate present with them when reporting to the police.

Law enforcement officers are available to answer questions, take reports, and refer to the appropriate jurisdiction, depending on where the crime occurred.

Medical Assistance

Survivors may seek medical care to test for sexually transmitted infections, pregnancy or physical injury.

Please note: Medical providers must report a sexual assault or domestic violence incident to law enforcement; that does not mean that the survivor/victim has to file a report or speak with the police if they do not want to.

Forensic Exams: To obtain a free forensic exam, contact Valley Crisis Center or law enforcement.

Forensic exams are initiated by law enforcement with confidential options. The forensic exam collects evidence for a criminal investigation. An advocate can provide assistance with this process, provide transportation, and accompany the survivor to the exam.
