

# CSU Application Commonly Asked Questions

(Note: one application is required for all CSU's)

1. **How much is the application fee?**
  - a. Application is \$70 per campus
2. **Will I qualify for a fee waiver if I'm in the EOP&S program?**
  - a. Yes, but you will have to answer questions on Quadrant 1: *Financial Information* and Quadrant 3: *EOP&S questions*
3. **Where can I find the SSID number?**
  - a. The SSID number is not needed for transfer applicants
4. **What do I put for my academic status?**

a.

Freshman: 0-29 semester credits
Sophomore: 30-58 semester credits
Junior: 60-89 semester credits
Senior: 90+ semester credits

- b. **To determine academic status, refer to units completed to find the total number of credits completed!**

5. **What is deemed transferrable?**
  - a. Any course number 1-49 is transferrable.
    - i. For example: Math 20A or Hist. 17A
6. **Why isn't my course listed when I type in the course code?**
  - a. If your course does not appear on the drop-down list automatically, manually enter the course subject and number exactly as it is listed on your transcript.
  - b. Department prefixes (Subject) and course numbers must exactly match what appears on your official transcript. Do not enter any space between the subject and the number (e.g. enter "BIOL2," not "BIOL 2")
7. **Do I have to put ALL of my courses? Even if they are not transferrable?**
  - a. Yes. All course work must be entered in the application
