

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO FORM
SCHOOL FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 2024-1
OF THE MERCED COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to California Education Code Sections 15320 and 15321, of the intention of the Board of Trustees (“Board”) of the Merced Community College District (“District”), located in the Counties of Merced and Fresno, to institute proceedings for the establishment of a school facilities improvement district (“Improvement District No. 2024-1”) pursuant to Title 1, Division 1, Part 10, Chapter 3 of the California Education Code, commencing with Education Code Section 15300 (the boundaries of which are located solely in Merced County). Improvement District No. 2024-1 would be formed for the purpose of calling one or more bond measure elections within Improvement District No. 2024-1 on the question of whether general obligation bonds should be issued with respect to the territory within Improvement District No. 2024-1 to provide financing for described public educational facilities of the District. A map/description of the proposed boundaries of Improvement District No. 2024-1 are on file with the District and is available for public review upon request at the District’s business offices.

The Board has adopted Resolution No. 24-20 stating its intention to form School Facilities Improvement District No. 2024-1 of the Merced Community College District. The text of Resolution No. 24-20 follows this notice. The Board has called a public hearing on the formation of the Improvement District to be held on June 25, 2024, at 4:00 p.m. or as soon thereafter as practicable, at the Merced College, Administration Building, Margaret M. Rudolph Boardroom, 3600 M Street, Merced, California. At the time and place set forth above for such hearing, the Board shall receive testimony concerning any matter set forth in Resolution No. 24-20. Any interested person, including all persons owning land in the Merced Community College District, and within the boundaries of proposed Improvement District No. 2024-1, may appear and be heard at such hearing.
